RDA Workshop

Resource Description and Access (RDA), is the new content standard for metadata, scheduled for release in 2009. RDA's goal is to improve resource discovery whether on the web, in traditional catalogues or other types of databases. RDA builds on the legacy of AACR2, and goes far beyond it; RDA brings a new perspective to resource description and access. Morning coffee break and lunch are included.

From Desk to Web: Creating Safety Nets in the Online Library

This hands-on workshop will teach useful techniques to help extend your reach as reference and instruction librarians beyond face-to-face encounters, and greatly increase users' success in getting the most out of your library's website.

During this workshop, participants will employ their expertise to identify and analyze the points in a library website where users stumble and often give up on the library. Then participants will design "safety nets" or support structures at those fail points that gently catch the users and help them be more successful researchers. Coffee break is included.
